

Terms and Conditions – EräViikingit ry

In order to use the myClub service, you must accept the following terms and conditions.

There may be people with different roles involved in the activities of EräViikingit ry. Registering in myClub does not automatically mean membership in the club, as myClub is also used for registration to other groups.

The club's most common forms of activity are:

- Team activities: league teams, adult lower division teams, or junior age-group teams (members only)
- Hobby team activities: neighbourhood hobby teams (members only)
- Floorball school and family floorball activities: floorball school or family floorball groups practicing once a week (members only)
- Free ball sports and floorball groups under the Finnish Model for Leisure Activities (no club membership)
- Camp activities during holiday periods (for both members and non-members)

In order for a participant to take part in any of the above-mentioned activities, the member or their guardian must register in myClub, accept the terms of their chosen activity type, and create a myClub account through which they can manage their membership profile.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING TERMS WHEN REGISTERING IN MYCLUB

1. The registrant or guardian is responsible for ensuring that the contact details in the club's membership register are up to date. Any inconvenience or costs caused by incorrect information are the responsibility of the registrant/guardian.
2. In the case of a minor registrant, guardian information must also be provided. The guardian is responsible for obligations and payments related to the minor's membership.
3. The club sends invoices through myClub. The guardian must ensure that myClub includes information on how and where invoices are delivered (or as e-invoices). All invoices are also visible in myClub, which can be accessed through a browser or mobile application. No invoices are sent for free activities.
4. Cancellation of registration or discontinuation of participation must always be made in writing. A phone call or simply not attending is not sufficient as cancellation. Different club activities have their own conditions regarding discontinuation during the season, so please read them carefully below.
5. The club may provide participation information of members to the City of Helsinki for supervision purposes of the club's activities.

Please note that registering in myClub alone does not constitute membership. In addition, the membership fee for the selected activity type must be paid. A person registering for the free Finnish Model for Leisure Activities groups does not become a club member.

EräViikingit wants to provide all players, coaches, officials, parents, and supporters with a safe and equal environment for participating and competing in floorball. The club's values are: quality, community, respect, and responsibility.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION TERMS

Please familiarize yourself carefully with the fees and payment/cancellation terms related to EräViikingit ry activities before registering, as they depend on the activity type you participate in.

By registering, the registrant/guardian of a minor accepts the invoices arising from the activities of the group and/or team as well as the club's payment and cancellation terms. The resulting payments are subject to debt collection procedures.

The terms for different activity types are listed below:

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO PARTICIPANTS IN FLOORBALL SCHOOLS, FAMILY FLOORBALL, OR YOUTH PLAY GROUPS AND THEIR GUARDIANS:

- The participation fee always applies to the entire autumn or spring season. Although payment may be split into two installments, these are not monthly fees but two parts of the seasonal fee.
- The full autumn or spring season fee must be paid in full if the participant has taken part in the activity, regardless of the number of sessions attended (excluding cancellation after trial sessions).
- If participation begins during the season (after the starting month), the fee is determined according to the remaining practice sessions after the starting date, and the exact price will be calculated by the club office.

- You may try the activity free of charge up to two times after registration (trial sessions). If you do not wish to continue after the trial sessions, the registration must be cancelled immediately by email (toimisto@eraviikingit.fi).
- The membership fee for these groups is invoiced together with the autumn or spring season participation fee. The membership fee is already included in the price and is not charged separately.
- Participants registering in the autumn are automatically included in the spring season as well.
- Participation for the spring season may be cancelled in writing by email at the end of the autumn season no later than December 31. In this case, the spring season fee will not be charged.
- No refunds are given for cancellations made during the autumn or spring season.
- In cases of long-term illness or injury, please contact our office regarding possible compensation.

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO PARTICIPANTS IN NEIGHBORHOOD HOBBY TEAMS AND THEIR GUARDIANS:

- Registration takes place at the beginning of the season, or participants may join mid-season if there is room in the hobby team. Participation is generally intended for the whole season.
- In hobby teams, the monthly fee billing period is from September to May, and the club membership fee is also charged in September.
- If joining mid-season, the membership fee is invoiced upon joining and the monthly fee starts from the month of participation.
- The monthly fee for hobby team activities is presented in the parent information package, hobby team materials, and at:

- If a participant quits during the season, payment for the month of quitting and the following month must still be paid. Notice of quitting must be given in writing by email (toimisto@eraviikingit.fi).
- Players in hobby teams must independently purchase a Floorball Federation player license and insurance if necessary in order to participate in tournaments.
- In cases of long-term illness or injury, please contact our office.

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO PARTICIPANTS IN JUNIOR AGE-GROUP TEAMS AND THEIR GUARDIANS, IF THE PLAYER IS A MINOR:

- Joining junior teams is done either through application or registration depending on the team. If necessary, please ask the team manager of the age group for more information.
- Participation in junior teams is generally intended for the entire season.
- Members playing in junior age-group teams pay the membership fee decided at the spring meeting. The membership fee always applies to the full season and is not refunded if the player quits during the season.
- Members playing in junior age-group teams pay a seasonal fee according to their team's budget, collected in smaller installments. You can obtain your team's budget from the team manager or financial manager.
- Any mid-season quitting is handled in accordance with the club's financial policy. In case of quitting, the participant must first contact the team manager and head coach. Simply not attending practices is not considered sufficient notice.
- Junior age-group teams follow the club's financial policy for junior teams, which also includes information regarding long-term injuries/illnesses, overdue payments, and playing with another club team.

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO MEMBERS OF MEN'S OR WOMEN'S LEAGUE TEAMS:

The responsibilities and obligations of players and officials in EräViikingit's men's and women's league teams are defined in player and staff agreements made with all members of those teams.

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO MEN'S OR WOMEN'S LOWER DIVISION TEAMS (3RD DIVISION, 4TH DIVISION):

Players in EräViikingit's men's and women's lower division teams are club members, and their membership fee is included in the team's other fees. These teams internally agree on other terms regarding players' commitment to the team and season. If necessary, contact your team's responsible person.

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO PARTICIPANTS REGISTERING FOR THE FINNISH MODEL FOR LEISURE ACTIVITIES GROUPS:

- The Finnish Model for Leisure Activities groups are free hobby groups organized by the City of Helsinki. EräViikingit is responsible for instructing designated groups.
- Guardians must register their child for the desired group so the child can participate. Registered children do not become club members; they are registered in myClub so the club knows the participants' names and can inform families if necessary.
- If a group is full, participants may join a waiting list, but they cannot participate until another participant cancels their place.
- If participation in a Finnish Model for Leisure Activities group is discontinued during the season, cancellation must be submitted in writing to our office (toimisto@eraviikingit.fi).

THE FOLLOWING TERMS APPLY ONLY TO PARTICIPANTS REGISTERING FOR CLUB CAMPS:

- Camp registration becomes binding once completed in myClub and an invoice has been issued.
- Cancellations are possible up to two weeks before the start of the camp. After that, camp fees may only be refunded in cases of illness against a medical certificate.
- If cancellation due to illness occurs less than two weeks before the camp starts, a €10 office fee will still be charged.
